ORDINANCE NO. 1

An Ordinance to Provide For a General Revision And Compilation of The Ordinances of the Village of Newberry.

THE VILLAGE OF NEWBERRY ORDAINS:

Section 1:1 Revision and Compilation:

All of the Ordinances of the Village of Newberry shall be revised, compiled and printed in looseleaf booklet form and when so revised, compiled and printed, the same shall be known and cited as the Compiled Ordinances of the Village of Newberry, Michigan.

Section 1:2 Inclusions:

All Ordinances now in effect and not hereinafter repealed in this compilation and all Ordinances and revisions and amendments thereof hereafter enacted by said Village shall be incorporated in and become a part of said Compiled Ordinances.

Section 1:3 Keeping Compilation Up to Date:

It shall be the duty of the Village Attorney and the Village Clerk to keep said Compiled Ordinance up to date by adding thereto or deleting therefrom all newly enacted or repealed Ordinances or revisions and amendments thereof.

Section 1:4 Printing, Distribution and Sale:

There shall be printed in said booklet form at least 50 copies of said Compiled Ordinances, and when so printed the Village Clerk shall deliver one copy thereof, without charge, to each official of said Village and to such other officials and persons as may require the same in some

public capacity. However, the Clerk shall maintain a listing of all persons receiving a copy, including current mailing addresses.

A copy of said Compiled Ordinances shall be open to public inspection at the office of said Village during all regular business hours, and any person may obtain a copy thereof by paying \$50.00. Additional copies shall be printed as requested.

Section 1:5 Publication:

It shall be the duty of the Village Clerk to immediately publish all Ordinances, Revisions and Amendments in the Newberry News. It shall be the duty of the Village Clerk and the Village Attorney to maintain proof of all publications.

Section 1:6 Franchises and Utilities:

All Ordinances relative to Franchise granted by said Village and all Ordinances relative to the Village owned utilities shall be included in said compilation in a separate chapter thereof entitled "Franchise and Utilities" and all Ordinances included in said chapter shall be designated by letter instead of any number.


Section 1:7 Publication and Effective Date:

The clerk shall cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published in the Newberry News within 15 days and further shall make copies of this Ordinance available for public inspection at the Village Offices located in the NEWBERRY WATER & LIGHT BUILDING.


This Ordinance shall be effective twenty (20) days after adoption. (August 3, 1987).


