

ORDINANCE NO. 6

An Ordinance Relative to the Construction, Maintenance, Repair and Use of the Sidewalks, Streets and Alleys.

THE VILLAGE OF NEWBERRY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 6:1 Construction of Sidewalk, Street or Alley Improvement:

Construction, repair or improvement may be made by the written petition of the property owners to be benefitted by such construction, repair or improvement.

6:1:1 Cost Sharing:

Any public improvement so initiated and constructed thereunder may be made upon any basis, including a proportionate cost basis that may be agreed upon by the Council and interested property owners.

Section 6:2 Sidewalks:

No person shall construct, re-construct, repair or remove any sidewalks excepting in accordance with the line, grade, slope or specifications established by the Council through its Village Engineer.

6:2:1 Openings:

No person shall make or use any opening in a sidewalk within the said Village, unless said opening is provided with suitable protection or unless approved by Village Council or Village Engineer.

Section 6:3 Trees and Shrubs:

No person shall plant any shade tree or shrub within the limits of any street or alley within the Village of Newberry.

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Section 6:4 Penalty and Violation:


Any person violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not in excess of \$500.00 and costs of prosecution or by imprisonment not in excess of ninety (90) days or by both fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 6:5 Publication and Effective Date:


The clerk shall cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published in the Newberry News within 15 days and further shall make copies of this Ordinance available for public inspection at the Village Offices located in the NEWBERRY WATER & LIGHT BUILDING.

This Ordinance shall be effective twenty (20) days after adoption. (August 3, 1987).
