

ORDINANCE NO. 19

An Ordinance to limit and control the placing of snow, ice, or other material in the streets and alleys in the Village of Newberry.

THE VILLAGE OF NEWBERRY ORDAINS:

Section 19:1 Snow and Ice Removal:

No person, firm, corporation or occupant shall take or remove, or cause to be removed, any snow, ice or other material from any property owned, occupied or controlled by him and pile or dump same within the lines of any street or alley of the Village of Newberry, except as herein provided.

Section 19:2 Piling Snow:

Any such person, firm, corporation, or occupant may take and remove snow or ice from a driveway twelve (12) feet or less in width on such property and pile same in a public street or alley, but only along and parallel with, and as part of the bank of snow formed by the Village of Newberry in its snow plowing operations. Such snow or ice shall be piled on the bank immediately in front of and adjacent to the property so owned or occupied and in no event shall the snow or ice so placed extend more than two feet six inches (2'6") further into the roadway or alleyway than the existing bank.

Section 19:3 Sidewalks:

No person, firm or corporation or occupant shall take or remove, or cause to be removed, any snow, ice or other material from any public walk or from the banks of snow formed by the Village of Newberry in its plowing operations and pile or dump same within the street or alley right-of-way in such manner as to reduce the width between the banks of snow formed by the Village of Newberry in its plowing operations by more than two feet six inches (2'6"). owners or occupants require large areas to be cleared adjacent to their properties and do not desire to wait until normal plowing or removal operations are carried out, such owner or occupant shall carry out the necessary removal operations at their own costs.

Section 19:4 Charge For Snow Removal:

Snow, ice or other material moved, piled or dumped in violation of this Ordinance may be moved by the city and the expense of such removal charged to the party found in violation of the Ordinance.

Section 19:5 Hazardous Removal of Snow and Ice:

As used in this Ordinance, "safety vision" means an unobstructed line of sight which enables a driver to travel on, enter, or exit a roadway in a safe manner.

19:5:1

A person shall not remove, or cause to be removed, snow, ice, or slush onto or across a roadway or shoulder of the roadway in a manner which obstructs the "safety vision" of the driver of a motor vehicle other than an off-road vehicle.

19:5:2

A person shall not deposit, or cause to be deposited, snow, ice or slush onto or across a roadway or the shoulder of the roadway in a manner which obstructs the "safety vision" of the driver of a motor vehicle.

19:5:3

A person shall not deposit or cause to be deposited snow, ice, or slush on any roadway or highway.

Section 19:6 Penalty:


Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction be fined not less than \$10.00 or more than \$500.00 together with the costs of prosecution or by imprisonment for a term of not more than ten (10) days.

Section 19:7 Publication and Effective Date:

The clerk shall cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published in the Newberry News within 15 days and further shall make copies of this Ordinance available for public inspection at the Village Offices located in the NEWBERRY WATER & LIGHT BUILDING.

This Ordinance shall be effective twenty (20) days after adoption. (August 3, 1987).
