

ORDINANCE NO. 22

An Ordinance regulating the storage of combustible and flammable materials within the Village of Newberry, Michigan for the protection and safety of the inhabitants thereof.

THE VILLAGE OF NEWBERRY, ORDAINS:

Section 22:1 Flammable Liquid,; Storage Prohibited:

That, all flammable liquid materials, such as gas line and oil (excluding and exempting the storage of fuel oil used for heating purposes) shall not be stored or provided for within the Village of Newberry, Michigan, without the express written permission of the Village Council, upon the recommendation of the Fire Chief of the said Village of Newberry, Michigan.

Section 22:2 Right To Refuse Delivery:

That, this Ordinance shall give the right to any person selling said flammable liquid materials the right to refuse delivery to any person unless the said person or persons show a permit issued by the Village Council and approved by the Fire Chief, as indicated above.

Section 22:3 Exceptions:

That all fuel oil used for heating purposes and all flammable liquids to tub gasoline containers of five (5) gal, or less, capacity shall be exempted from the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 22:4 Penalty:

Any person violating any of the provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 together with costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment not in excess of


90 days, or by both such fine or imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. Provided, however, that no warrant shall be issued for the violation of this Ordinance, and if the person charged with such violation shall within 5 days after such violation pay to the Village Clerk the sum of \$25.00.

Section 22:5 Publication and Effective Date:

The clerk shall cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published in the Newberry News within 15 days and further shall make copies of this Ordinance available for public inspection at the Village Offices located in the NEWBERRY WATER & LIGHT BUILDING.

This Ordinance shall be effective twenty (20) days after adoption. (August 3, 1987).
