

ORDINANCE 27

An Ordinance relative to the public health and safety in connection with the water supply for the Village of Newberry, Michigan and to provide penalties for the violation thereof.

THE VILLAGE OF NEWBERRY ORDAINS:

Section 27:1 Unlawful Contamination:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to construct, erect, establish or maintain any sewage or water draining systems or any other sources of contamination within 150 feet of any village or municipal owned water well.

Section 27:2 Penalty:

Any person, firm or officer of a corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, on conviction, be sentenced to pay of fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution or to imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both, such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. Each day that a person, firm, or corporation shall allow such contamination to exist shall be considered a separate violation of this Ordinance.


Section 27:3 Publication and Effective Date:

The clerk shall cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published in the Newberry News within 15 days and further shall make copies of this Ordinance available for public inspection at the Village Offices located in the NEWBERRY WATER & LIGHT BUILDING.


